**The Essex County Council (Various Roads Waltham Abbey) (Eastern Electric Maiden Voyage Festival) (Special Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023
The Essex County Council (A121 Meridian Way, Waltham Abbey) (Temporary prohibition of right-hand turn) (Eastern Electric Maiden Voyage Festival) Order 2023**

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council intends, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Orders under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

Effect of the Order

1. To temporarily close the following length of roads, Waltham Abbey in the District of Epping Forest.

A121 Highbridge Street, Waltham Abbey	From the Essex boundary (Centre of the western bridge crossing the river Lee), East to the crossroads with Meridian Way and Beaulieu Drive approximately 150 metres	26 August 2023 (Sat) 00:01 to 05:00. 26 August 2023 (Sat) 20:00 to 27 August 2023 (Sun) 01:00 27 August 2023 (Sun) 20:00 to 23:59 28 August 2023 (Mon) 00:01 to 01:00
Beaulieu Drive Waltham Abbey	From the junction with A121 for its entire length (Resident access only) Will be marshalled.	26 August 2023 (Sat) 10:00 to 23:59 27 August 2023 (Sun) 10:00 to 23:59
Fishers Green Lane Waltham Abbey	From its junction with B194 Crooked Mile for its entire length (Resident access only) Will be marshalled.	26 August 2023 (Sat) 10:00 to 23:59 27 August 2023 (Sun) 10:00 to 23:59

2. To introduce a prohibition of right-hand turn from A121 Meridian Way into Highbridge Retail Park. Restriction will be in place **26 August 2023** 10:00 to 23:59 and **27 August 2023** 10:00 to 23:59

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public while vehicles/pedestrians egress the Eastern Electric Maiden Voyage event at Lee Valley Park. The times as above.

There is no alternative route for Beaulieu Drive or Fishers Green Lane.

The alternative route for the closure in the Essex area will be A121 Meridian Way, A112 Sewardstone Road, south for approximately 3.68 KM (2.3 Miles) where Sewardstone Road goes into the Borough of Waltham Forest. Then it will be A110 Lea Valley Road, A1055 Mollison Avenue, Hereford Road, High Street, A1010 Monarch's Way, A121 Eleanor Cross Road and vice versa



Access for emergency vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The Order will come into Operation 26 August 2023 and may continue in force for 18 months or until all the event has taken place, whichever is the earlier.

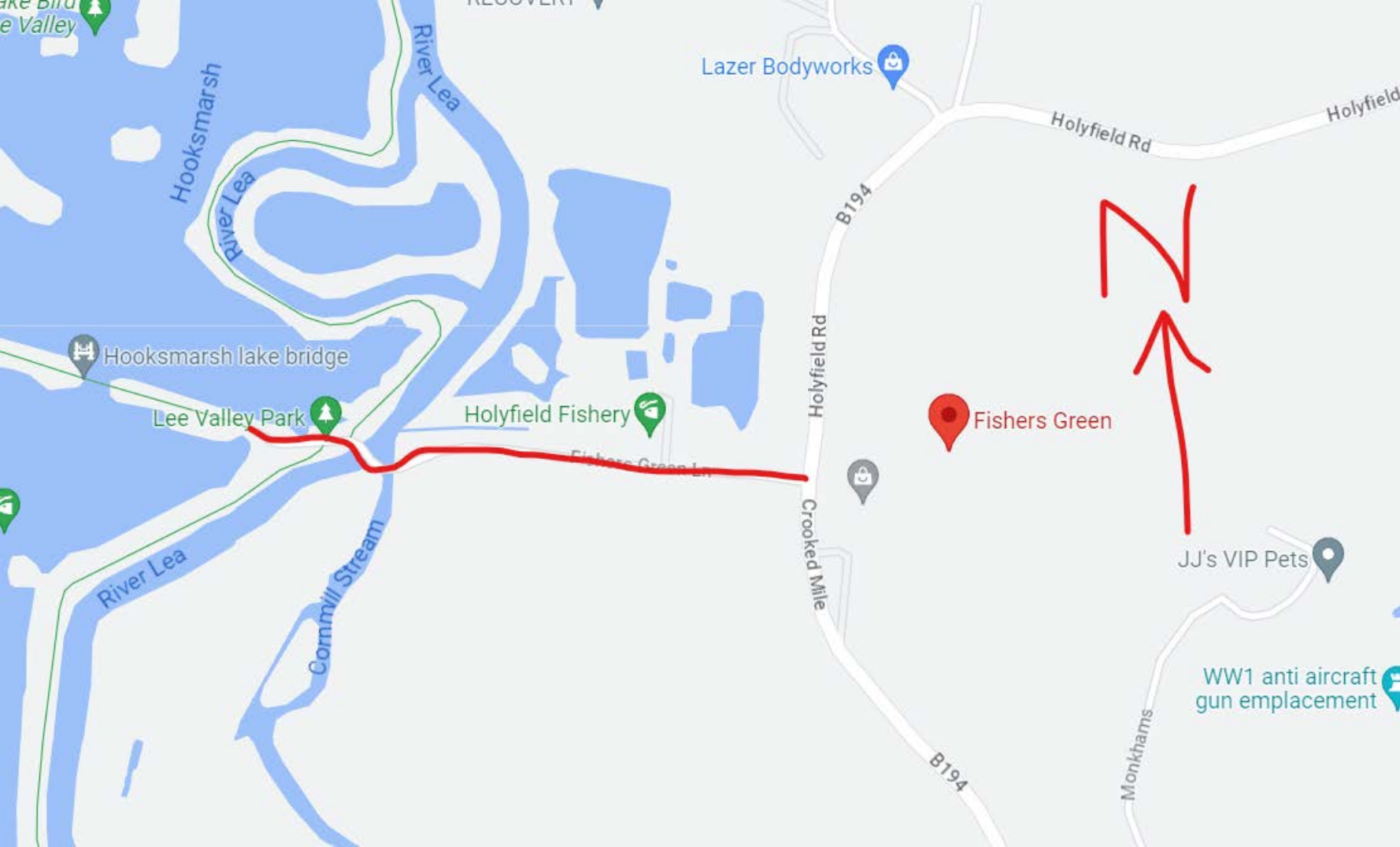

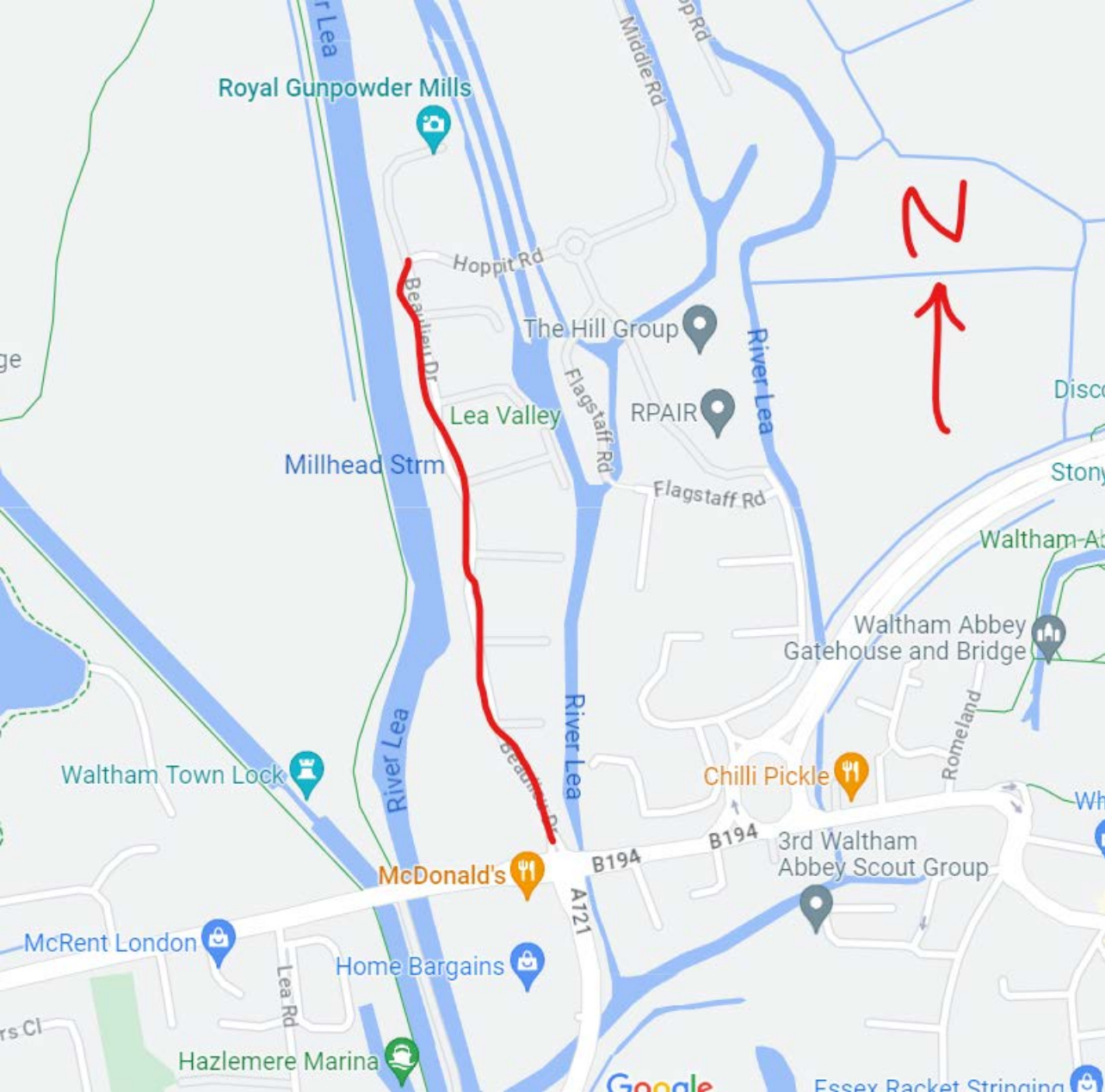
